NOTE:  
The definition of the coastal zone is:  
"the mobile beach zone and modern (Holocene) dune system; mangroves and wetlands and flats subject to tidal influence; areas potentially subject to shoreline movements, coastal waters, the seabed (seaward to the three nautical mile State limit) and off shore islands, including gulfs and sounds, under the jurisdiction of the Western Australian Government; and estuaries and associated section of waterways with tidal influence and coastal lagoons" (SWCC regional strategy, 2005).
